


Cayce Utilities Department Warns Residents of Sewer Main Break

CAYCE, SC – Today at 12:45 p.m., the City of Cayce Utilities Department was notified of a sewer overflow near the creek at Monkey Springs Branch. Utility crews were dispatched immediately to determine the cause. It has been determined that the cause of the sewer overflow was due to a sewer main break in front of 1340 Knox Abbott Drive in Cayce.

SC DHEC has been notified of the spill and the City is taking all proper precautions. The City utility officials are in the process of repairing the sewer main.

All residents are asked to please stay away from the area around the creek at Monkey Springs Branch all the way down to the river. Additionally, Granby Gardens Park will also be closed during the cleanup process.
