



Keep the Midlands Beautiful Receives \$10,000 Grant from Lowe's

Supports Cayce, South Carolina Community Improvement Project*

June 22nd, 2015 – Keep the Midlands Beautiful today announced that Lowe's has awarded a \$10,000 grant to support Keep the Midlands Beautiful's mission to help make Cayce, SC a clean, green and a more beautiful place to live.

The Keep America Beautiful/Lowe's grant will provide funding for the new Cayce Trailhead Park, to be completed in 2015 with the assistance of local [Lowe's Heroes employee volunteers](#). The overall goal of this project is to create a neighborhood trailhead park for citizens to enjoy. This will be in the Community of Riverland Park and will be a welcome addition of a green-space and playground area for the numerous neighborhood children but also for the numerous families that utilize the Riverwalk daily. Cayce Riverwalk Phase II ends in this neighborhood.

The Keep the Midlands Beautiful grant is one of 50 merit-based grants awarded nationally by Lowe's to community-based affiliates of Keep America Beautiful in support of grassroots service projects ranging from restoring neighborhood parks and planting community gardens to leading disaster restoration initiatives and large-scale cleanups.
