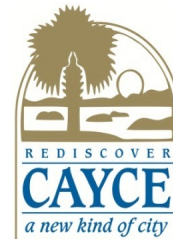


City of Cayce Issues Update on Parks & Trails

CAYCE, SC – The City of Cayce would like to issue the following update for all of our parks, trails and other recreational facilities around the city that were, or continue to be impacted by the recent flooding:

The Cayce Riverwalk:

- ***The Congaree River is expected to peak on Wednesday; therefore all phases will remain closed through the end of this week.***
- Phase 1 (from the N Avenue entrance to Blossom Street Bridge) – Closed; Expected to Reopen Next Week
- Phase 2 (from the N Avenue entrance to Riverland Park) – Closed Until Further Notice for Substantial Repairs
- Phase 3 (from Riverland Park to the Thomas Newman Boat Landing) – Closed [until Further Notice](#)
- Phase 4 (from the Thomas Newman Boat Landing to Timmerman Trail) – Closed; Expected to Reopen Next Week

Timmerman Trail:

- (Entrance near Cayce Tennis and Fitness Facility on Ft. Congaree Trail) – Closed; Expected to Reopen Next Week

Other City Parks and Facilities:

- Thomas Newman Boat Landing (off of Old State Road) – Closed for Substantial Repairs; Parking Lot is open
- Riverland Park Entryway Park (Riverland Drive) – Closed for Planned Improvements
- Granby Gardens Park (at City Hall Complex) – Currently open; but will be closed [November 16 – January 2016 for Christmas in Cayce](#)
- All Other [City Parks](#) are Currently Open
