Officers and Firefighters with the Cayce Department of Public Safety will host a Child Seat Checkpoint on **December 16, 2015** from **2:30-5:00 PM** at the Parkland Plaza shopping center near **440 Knox Abbott Dr.**

Officers and Firefighters, who are also certified Child Passenger Seat Technicians, will be checking to make sure car seats are installed correctly and instruct parents on the best passenger seat types for their child's age and weight range. They will also make sure a car seat is not damaged, improperly modified, expired, or under recall. In the event you are involved in a collision over the holidays, 10 minutes of your time at a child seat check could possibly prevent serious injury.

The checkpoint comes as the final requirement for a three day child seat technician training course being taught by officials from SCDHEC's Office of Injury & Violence Prevention. This training will certify an additional 15 technicians that will assist the 3 technicians the department has currently.
