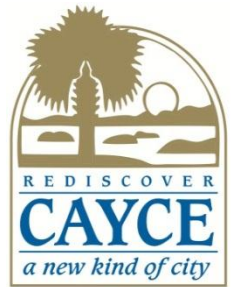


City of Cayce Announces Date & Lineup for 6th Annual Congaree Bluegrass Festival
