CAYCE, SC – The City of Cayce would like to issue the following update for all of our parks, trails and other recreational facilities around the city that were, or continue to be impacted by the recent flooding:

The Cayce Riverwalk:

- Phase 1 (from the N Avenue entrance to Blossom Street Bridge) – **Will Reopen Saturday**
- Phase 2 (from the N Avenue entrance to Riverland Park) – Closed Until Further Notice for Substantial Repairs
- Phase 3 (from Riverland Park to the Thomas Newman Boat Landing) - Closed; Expected to Reopen Next Week
- Phase 4 (from the Thomas Newman Boat Landing to Timmerman Trail) – **Will Reopen Saturday**

Timmerman Trail:

- (Entrance near Cayce Tennis and Fitness Facility on Ft. Congaree Trail) – **Will Reopen Saturday**

Other City Parks and Facilities:

- Thomas Newman Boat Landing (off of Old State Road) – Closed for Substantial Repairs; Parking Lot Reopens on Saturday
- Riverland Park Entryway Park (Riverland Drive) – Closed for Planned Improvements
- Granby Gardens Park (at City Hall Complex) – Closed for Planned Electrical Improvements
- All Other [City Parks](#) are Currently Open

Facts & Other Information From #SCFloods

- Parks staff removed over 500 tons of sediment/silt from the Riverwalk parks alone, this does not count trees and other large items.
- Staff was not able to get to all of the Parks and start clean up until last Thursday. They have been working tirelessly since then. Parts of Phase 3 and the Boat Landing are still wet.
- Lighting and Call Boxes are being returned to their normal places.
- We encourage our residents to exercise caution while using the Riverwalk. Please stay on the designated path and be aware of barricades and cones.
- The flooding has pushed some of the wildlife closer to the pathways, so please pay attention to your surroundings.
