City of Cayce Issues a Sanitary Sewer System Overflow Notification

In the area near
State Street and Martin Marietta in
Cayce, SC on the Congaree River and Cayce Riverwalk

Cayce, SC - According to City of Cayce City Manager Rebecca Vance, on January 22, 2016, the City of Cayce experienced an overflow of Sanitary Sewer in the area near Martin Marietta and the Cayce Riverwalk on the Congaree River.

The City of Cayce Wastewater Collection Department identified the Sanitary Sewer overflow at 11:00 AM.

A broken force main led to the overflow in the sewer system and as a result, caused an on-going amount of sanitary sewer to be introduced into the Congaree River. The City of Cayce is currently working on making the repair and expect to have it completed within seven to fourteen days.

SC DHEC has been notified of the spill.
